3. Summary of stakeholder engagement

Richard

May was another big month for workshop deliveries, a record. Strong demand means we continue to book workshop into the coming year. Improvements to the database mean that we can now have the % numbers for attitude changes of those attending workshops calculated and inserted into the monthly report window automatically reducing errors and improving accuracy. We have been putting effort into the busy area between Mt Maunganui and Tauranga which has huge truck movements, and a lot of cycle commuters. A number of toolbox workshops have been held and are planned over the coming month. Several Blindzone demonstrations and Workshops were held. One of these was covered by NZ Herald. There have been a number of tragic deaths of bicycle riders over the last few weeks due to crashes with trucks.

Some time ago when talking with the Minister of Transport it emerged that he had not been in a big truck. The ride on the 14th of May was a success. We appreciated Golden Bay Cement for taking him from their Auckland CBD port deport up to the Mt Eden CRL railway site at 8:00am in the morning when there were a lot of cyclists on the road.

A third request was made for a Blindzone Kit that is used to run Blindzone Demonstrations and Workshops by Rotorua Lakes Council. Auckland Transport and Tauranga City Council have recently ordered (and paid) for their own. We have trained staff and volunteers the three councils use to run Blindzone events and workshops.

We have started the process of creating a business case for Debbie Lang to put to Waka Kotahi for funding the next financial years workshops. We need to fund the next 12 months activities with the same amount of money we were given for the last 11 months.

Kelvin

May has continued to be really busy month with a lot of workshops and interest in the blindzone training. We are deep in the peak of school road teams doing the workshop and they have been very successful.

Fonterra have been a brilliant supporter providing trucks and drivers for six separate blindzone events. Drivers have been without fail some of the best I've worked with and really good ambassadors for very considerate driving and professionalism. I have managed to secure trucks for all workshops, though with our extra demand in recent months it has been tight at times. Auckland events can usually be covered by one of either TR Group, Fonterra or Waste Management. I've contacted Linfox through a parent from the Sacred Heart College Cycling team who has indicated they will be able to support. This should take any pressure off when the other companies are unable to provide a vehicle.

I worked alongside AT ambassadors who delivered a BZ demonstration at an AT bike fix up event who are getting the STR message across really well to the public. It was a couple of days after we lost a cyclist in a crash with a truck and people were very aware of the death and very open to our demonstration.

The last week of the month was particularly busy with 6 events over 3 days including 3 blindzone workshops with 3 schools on Sunday 30th. Schools are all really keen and most want to make the BZW an annual event to keep the message fresh in the minds of their riders. The St Kentigern College coach wants to invite STR to a schools training event at Pukekohe. The recent spate of cycling/truck fatalities is clearly a motivation on parents and coaches.

I delivered my first BZW with a road (lycra) cycling group the Department of Cycling from West Auckland. Really positive session with 35 roadies thru the workshop and it was really well received. Suggested next steps is working thru the shop rides which I will be working on networking once school road teams are all thru the program.

I have a few more schools to reschedule after a cancellation and experimenting with a few riding groups including running a demo/workshop at a Triple Teez expo event in Mangere Queens Birthday Monday.
